
#### Logging in



To start working on Raz-Kids, you first have to navigate to the page using the URL <a href="https://www.raz-kids.com">https://www.raz-kids.com</a>.

Underneath the grey icon that says "Available on the App Store" there is a hyperlink that says "continue to KidsA-Z.com" in a very small font. Click this.








Logging in

The website will then ask for the student's password. Type in their password provided here. Make sure the correct student's name is at the top.




# Accessing Reading Room

Click on the spaceship that's labeled "Reading Room."







## Reading Room

Use the arrows on the right side of the screen to scroll through different options and books. Or click "View All" to see all books.




To find books at your student's reading level, click on the icon that says "Leveled Books" at the top of the page. You can also find books in Spanish here.



#### Leveled Books



From clicking on the icon that says "Leveled Books", choose your student's reading level to access all available books at that specific level.





To start reading a book, click on the icon under the book that looks like an open book.



To listen to the guided audio reading of the book, click the icon that looks like headphones.





### Leveled Books



When reading the book, you can switch between pages using the "Next" and "Back" arrows on the left and right side of the screen.
